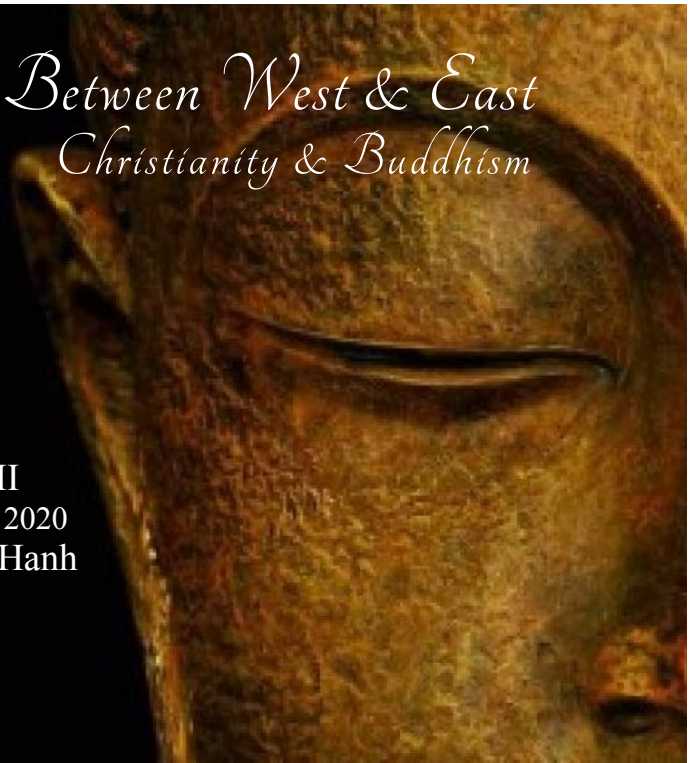


# Dialogue Between West & East Christianity & Buddhism
