
THE LABYRINTH WALK Labyrinth Days at Mercy Center

Saturday May 7th is World Labyrinth Day when people the world over will walk the labyrinth for peace at one o'clock their local time. We walk at "one as one," spreading prayers for peace around the world. Bring your journal if you have one to note anything that comes to you after your walk. Gather at 1:00pm at the Labyrinth for a brief orientation before we begin.

Tuesday, June 21st is the summer solstice, the longest day of the year. You are invited to experience an evening labyrinth walk as we celebrate God's movement in creation, an opportunity to slow down, open our hearts, and welcome what comes as the daylight hours begin to wane. We will walk at sunset by torchlight. Bring a journal or other creative materials if you wish. Sundown is 8:34 on June 21st. Gather at 8:15pm at the Labyrinth for a brief Orientation before we begin our pilgrimage to the center. You may bring a journal and a flashlight.
