## Advanced Enneagram\* Living in Healthy Relationship(s) January 20-22, 2023

One indication that we are moving towards a holistic or integrated spirituality—that we are living in healthy relationship with God—is to consider how we are living in relationship with others. The focus of this workshop will be an exploration of these relationships (or personality types) that are cause for frustration or conflict, and shine a light on the blind or shadow places to *be seen* and to *see* into the deeper truth from where we can set free our defense patterns, expectations, projections.

\*Participants will need to know their own Enneagram Type by having completed an introductory Enneagram workshop or course and have some familiarity with all nine Enneagram types.
