Mystics throughout the ages have stressed the role of the sacred imagination in helping us move beyond what we think we know and open to God's mystery. This can take many forms, from imaginative engagement with scripture to prayerful attention to dreams and reverie. This silent retreat will draw on the work of two groundbreaking figures, St. Ignatius of Loyola and Carl Jung, who devoted their lives to helping others use imagination to connect with the divine.

In addition to introducing these very different spiritual thinkers and the surprising overlap between them, the retreat will focus on accessing the sacred imagination through group exercises, journaling, and individual reflection. John Ensign, PHD, is a clinical psychologist and Jungian Analyst. He is also a spiritual director with extensive background in Christian Spirituality and the Contemplative Tradition.

Colleen Gregg, MA, is Director of Mercy Center Auburn, and serves as spiritual director, supervisor, retreat and workshop facilitator, and program and events coordinator.
