## The Beguine Movement & Meister Eckhart



The Beguine movement began in Medieval Europe, and still has much to teach us today regarding the practice of Spirituality. In this movement, women chose to live an Apostolic life based on the Gospels. They chose not be become nuns who lived in convents; they chose not to become wives and mothers. Rather they live together in community, apart from ecclesial authority.

Some Beguine women where important writers of Spirituality in the vernacular of the people (and not in academic Latin). To name three: Hadewijch of Brabant, Mechthild of Magdeburg and Marguerite Porete. This retreat will focus on the work of Porete: *The Mirror of Simple Souls*.

Meister Eckhart as a Dominican priest ministered to the Beguine community, and his sermons present a challenging and controversial Spirituality.

This retreat will go back are forth between these two great Spiritual Masters: Marguerite Porete and Meister Eckhart.
