

Departing Mercy Center

Generally, bedrooms must be vacated by noon on the day of departure. Occasionally, it may be necessary to vacate earlier if another group is arriving that day. You will be notified of this when you check-in. Remove linens from the bed, collect used towels and place them in designated hampers. Please turn off the heat or air conditioning in your bedroom and close the window. Return all keys.

Driving Directions

From Folsom: Take Auburn-Folsom Road east to Auburn. Turn right onto Sacramento Street.

From Sacramento or San Francisco: Take I-80 East towards Reno. Exit at Newcastle Road. Proceed straight through stoplight and continue about 2.5 miles to stop light. Turn left onto Auburn-Folsom Road and then turn right at 2nd light onto Sacramento Street.

From Sacramento International Airport: Take I-5 South (Los Angeles) to I-80 East towards Reno, then follow directions above.

From Reno/Lake Tahoe: Take I-80 West to Highway 49 Grass Valley/Placerville exit. Bear right onto Highway 49. Turn right onto Lincoln Way. Proceed to next light, and turn left onto Auburn-Folsom Road. Go through 3 lights (about 1.5 miles) and then turn left onto Sacramento Street.

From Grass Valley/Nevada City: Take Highway 49 through Auburn to the intersection at Lincoln Way. Turn right onto Lincoln Way. At next light, turn left onto Auburn-Folsom Road. Go through 3 lights, then turn left onto Sacramento Street.

From Placerville: Take Highway 49 through Coloma, Cool and into Auburn. As you come up from the canyon into Auburn, stay straight and go under the train bridge. Stay in the left lane and follow High Street through downtown until it intersects with Auburn Folsom Road. Turn left onto Auburn-Folsom Road. Go to third light and then turn left onto Sacramento Street.

GUIDELINES FOR HOSTED GROUPS

Guest Guidelines

Designate a Group Representative

Designate someone within your group to serve as host. This person must arrive during office hours in advance of other participants to receive an orientation to the Center. The orientation will include information about:

- ◆ Areas reserved for your use
- ◆ Bedroom accommodations
- ◆ Restroom accommodations
- ◆ Food service
- ◆ Security System

Check-in and Bedroom Assignments

Your designated host will be responsible for registration and bedroom assignment. Your group will be given a blank bedroom assignment form and may opt to pre-assign rooms or allow participants to choose their own room upon arrival. All bedrooms are single-occupancy with either single or double beds, a sink, desk, wardrobe, and chair. Towels, sheets and pillows are provided. Guests are asked to make their beds upon arrival and to remove used linens and place them in designated hampers before departing. If an extra blanket or pillow is desired, guests are encouraged to bring their own.

Bedroom Keys

We do not typically provide keys to our bedrooms, however, individual bedroom keys are available upon request. If you opt to distribute keys, you are responsible for collecting them before departure. Group/contact person on contract will be billed for cost to replace lost keys.

Restrooms/Showers

Communal/single-gender restrooms/showers are available on each floor.

Cell Phones/Computers

To maintain the quiet, prayerful atmosphere of the Center, we ask guests to refrain from cell phone use in and around the Center. Wireless internet is available throughout the Center.

Tobacco-Free Environment Policy

Security System

The Center has a keypad security system that works on four exterior doors. You will be given a 4-digit code when you arrive.

We ask that you mail, fax, or email a copy of your planned schedule to Mercy Center prior to your arrival. Please plan around the following meal times: Breakfast-7:30am; Lunch-12:00pm; Dinner-5:15 pm. Meal times cannot be adjusted.
