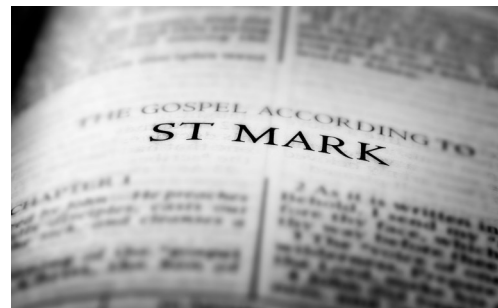




Pondering the Gospel of St. Mark
